Regular Share (8-month CSA)

A Regualr Share CSA consists of a weekly bag of seasonal vegetables and fruit intended to feed two adults. As a CSA member you are assured of having the best of what we grow over a 8-month period. (April-Nov.)

Lite Share (8-month CSA)

A Lite Share is just a smaller version of the Regular Share, containing four basic items from the variety available each week. (April-Nov.)

Egg CSA (quarterly)

We are proud to offer eggs produced by our pasturegrazed chickens. Our farm is Animal Welfare Approved so our chickens live under the highest and most humane standards. You can choose one, two, or onehalf dozen each week of the session. See Payment and Pickup section for details. (quarterly)

Fruit-Only CSA (in season)

This Fruit –Only CSA will provide strawberries, peaches, grapes, plums, summer melons, apples, pears, and crabapples. You will be notified by email when each fruit is "in season." You will then pick up at the farm or a designated location each week until the particular fruit has stopped producing. Of course, all of these are weather permitting. (Please read and sign the disclosure.)

During the season, we expect to have plenty of asparagus, beans, beets onions, tomatoes, herbs, squash, and cucumbers, just to name a few. We would love to fill "special requests" from our CSA members. If it can be grown in Oklahoma, we will give it a whirl.

What to expect from the Eaa CSA

Each week you will receive the freshest, tastiest eggs in this area. We are Animal Welfare Approved (AWA), undergoing a yearly audit to maintain the highest and most humane standards for our pasture-grazed chickens.

What to expect from the Fruit Only CSA

This unique option will give you fruit in season. It will begin approximately in April with strawberries and end with pumpkins in approximately November. You will receive an email when the fruit is ready for pick up. For example, the strawberries are available for about 4 weeks, the peaches for about 8 weeks, and the grapes for about 6 weeks.
